We are offering outside access to the Lamoille North Internet at all Lamoille North schools. We will be extending our “GuestOpen” wireless Internet connection to make it accessible from outside of all school buildings. Distance from the school building will affect your connection. The “GuestOpen” account does not require a password.
